Please note the following points carefully:

- Hill walking is an inherently dangerous activity. Boys and parents should be aware that whilst every step will be taken to minimise risk, accidents can still happen. You participate in expeditions on the understanding that you accept these risks.
- Boys are expected to behave in a sensible and courteous manner at all times. Normal school rules shall apply wherever possible.
- Boys are expected to comply fully with instructions from the staff of QEGS and Addventure Ltd, particularly where instructions are about safety.
- Boys are forbidden to bring valuable items, including mobile phones, iPods and jewellery.
- Boys are not permitted to smoke or drink alcohol, even if they are of legal age.
- Boys whose conduct is deemed unacceptable will be withdrawn from expedition (to be collected by parents) and may be banned from future expeditions.

I hereby authorize Peter McWilliam or any other member of QEGS staff or appointed instructing staff present to act as necessary on my behalf in an emergency, following reasonable attempts to contact me, and to sign on my behalf any consent forms for such medical treatment including blood transfusion and anaesthetic which, in the opinion of a qualified medical practitioner, may be immediately necessary for my son in the course of the expedition. I also give consent for my son to be transported in the vehicles of QEGS staff or appointed instructing staff, or in the vehicles of parents of other boys on expedition as necessary.
