Expedition Log Prompt Sheet

This sheet is designed to help you write your expedition log. The report should be word processed, font size 12:

- 2 sides of A4 for Bronze
- 3 sides of A4 for Silver
- 4 sides of A4 for Gold.

You must also include the following:

- Name and Form
- Expedition dates
- Award level

Spell check and READ your report before submitting it. The best logs will be printed in The Savillian. When writing your log you should consider the questions and points below:

Journeying

- Where and how far did you walk each day?
- Where did you camp?
- What were the weather conditions?
- What was the terrain like?
- Did you experience any navigational difficulties?
- What would you do differently?

Camping

- What did you eat? (Would you change your food for next time?)
- Where you comfy? (Too hot/cold/cramped/hungry/wet/etc)
- Who did you share your tent with?
- Any camping difficulties? (Burnt food/problems pitching the tent/snoring group members/etc)
- What would you do differently?

The Good, Bad and Ugly!

- What was the best moment of the expedition?
- What was the worst moment of the expedition?
- What aspect did you enjoy the most?
- Which pieces of equipment were most useful?
- Did you carry anything that you wouldn't carry next time?
- What advice would you give to a participant about to complete a similar expedition?

Only those who have completed assessments need write an expedition log!
